Dear fellow Blue Lake resident,

Here's my new **8 point plan** if re-elected:

1. Continue downward pressure on rates so any increases are below the State Government rate cap.
2. Retain in place, or by community, the gorgeous Apollo Parkways hydrant covers.
3. Ensure the rescoped \$1.1 million Diamond Valley Library redevelopment caters for young families, working from home businesses and mature age residents.
4. Ensure \$280,000 Ironbark Road streetscape is integrated with the major public artwork at Yan Yean Road. (Stage 2)
5. Pass the planning scheme amendment for a permit trigger for earthworks involving the importation of more than 100m³ of fill to all land. This will prevent a reoccurrence of the problem at Chapel Lane. I supported interim enforcement orders.
6. Make "Garden Court" the focus of the neighbourhood character strategy to protect the look and feel of our neighbourhoods.
7. Provide targeted assistance (registration/user fees etc) to community groups and sporting clubs in financial hardship due to Covid-19.
8. Be the first Council in Australia to define climate change, not just as an environmental problem, but also as a financial one.
